Lent 2: The Whip

Psalm Reading

Psalm 27

Old Testament Reading

Genesis 15:1-12, 17-18

Epistle Reading

Philippians 3:17-4:1

Gospel Reading

Luke 13:31-35 or Luke 9:28-36

Leader: *The Lenten symbol we bring to the cross today is the whip, an instrument of power and violence. Today in our Scripture readings we also consider the promises of God to Abram, freely given, without coercion. Because Abram trusted God, he was brought into right relationship, into God's own covenantal righteousness .*

People: *Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us. Too often we do violence in our relationships. We confess that we coerce, and are coerced, rather than living in trust. In the shadow of Your cross we cry, "Have mercy on us."*

Leader: *God's covenant with Abram came in deep and terrifying darkness. The new covenant Jesus offered in His blood came in the deep and terrifying darkness of our violence. In His life and death Jesus offered Himself, absorbing our violence and returning only love.*

People: *Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us. We live in the deep and terrifying darkness of our own violence. We confess our entrapment by the powers of this world. In the shadow of Your cross we cry, "Have mercy on us."*

Leader: *Let us pray together . . .*

ALL:

*O God, whose glory it is always to have mercy:
We look at Jesus, and we look at ourselves,
and we confess the great difference.
Deliver us from our violence;
conform us to His love.
We admit our helplessness apart from Your grace.
We thank You that through the resurrection
Your grace abundantly pardons and transforms us!
Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.*
