- 1 bottle shampoo (15 oz. or less)
- 1 bottle lotion (18 oz. or less) ’
- 1 solid deodorant (4 oz. or less)
- 1 small spray perfume/cologne/body mist (4 oz. or less)

Pack these separately in sandwich-size Zip-Lock bag please do NOT put in larger 2 gallon bag

- 1 tube antibacterial ointment (1 oz)
- 1 bottle of acetaminophen 500mg (24CT)
