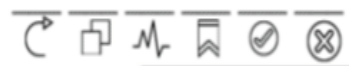
I was crying because I thought someone had moved Jesus' body, but then I heard Jesus say my name and saw Him standing before me! (John 20:1, 11-16)



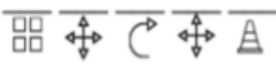
I spoke to some women and told them, "Do not be afraid; Jesus has risen from the dead!". (Matthew 28:5-6)
