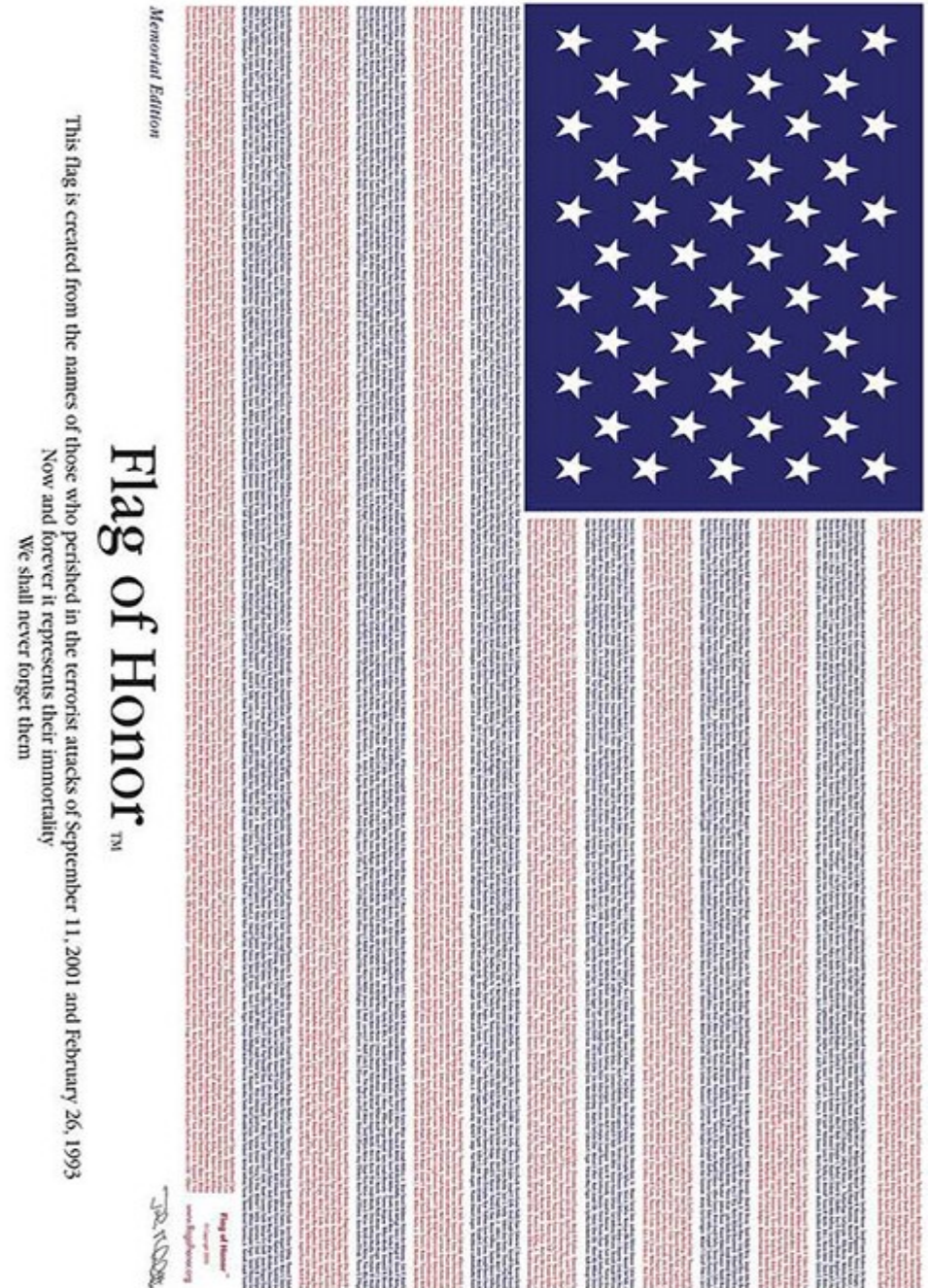

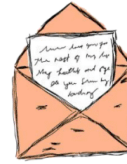

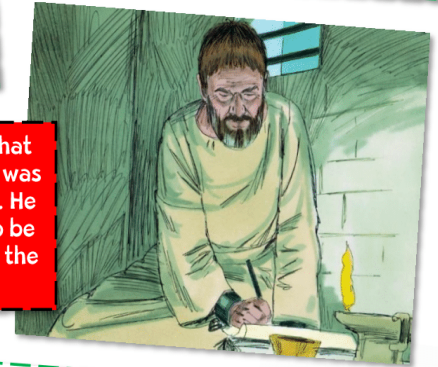

- ❖ Why is it important for us to keep guarding the gospel and pass it on unchanged like Paul did?

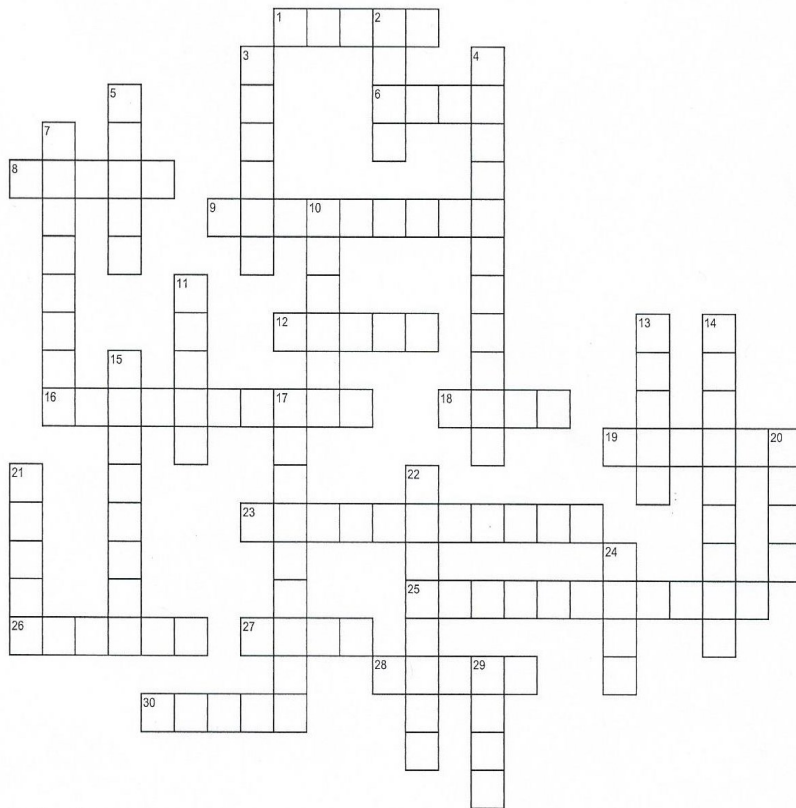

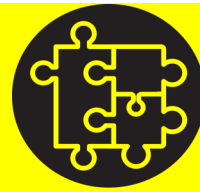
